


RU alum Todd Shalom (New York, 2013) was an outbound artist-in-residence at Akiyoshidai International Art Village (AIAV) in Yamaguchi, Japan. He is the founder of Elastic City, an artistic project and non-profit that commissioned participatory walks for the public, including walks led by RU alumni Tomaz Hipólito (Portugal, 2011) and Andrew Mount (England/California, 2011). Elastic City's final three-week festival "The Last Walk" took place in 2016 throughout NYC. In 2019, Elastic City released the now sold out book *Elastic City: Prompts for Participatory Walks*, which includes 48 prompts, walk ephemera, photos and contributions from more than 50 visual, performance and text-based artists. On August 15, RU alum Pedro Wirz (Brazil/Switzerland, 2014) opened the solo exhibition *Termite Terminators* at Marc Selwyn Fine Art in Los Angeles. Working with organic materials to explore perception, new works in the exhibition incorporate objects set in beeswax framed by scrap wood. In the exhibition text online, Giampaolo Bianconi writes: "Beeswax, with its longue durée, reveals in these works the presence of multiple timescalesthe eternity of the wax, the lifecycle of the toys, the limited lifespan of the vehicles they represent, and the potential futures embodied by the enigmatic cement eggs that have been scattered throughout the
